2.1 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after online entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

2.2 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event. Should a rider not have a transponder for this event, they will be scored a DNF regardless of how they placed.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased at each host club.

2.3 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

3 RACE INFORMATION

3.1 RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

The race format for the Wild Cat Cup is as follows:

Category	Race Format
Mini Wheelers / Sprockets	4 Motos
All other classes	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

4 AWARDS & PRIZING

4.1 CLUB TROPHIES

Winners trophy and Runner-up trophies are awarded to the Club (Lilydale or Park Orchards) with the most series points from both rounds based on the riders that are members at that club.

- Presentation will be held at the end of racing at Round 2 Lilydale BMX Club.

5 VENUE INFORMATION

The following are prohibited at Park Orchards BMX Club and Lilydale BMX Club

- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices)
